Siderophore Production by Bacteria Associated with Weedy Plants


Siderophores are produced by rhizosphere bacteria to solubilize unavailable forms of heavy metal bearing minerals by complexation. Soil and plant samples were collected from different



heavy metals contaminated areas of Jabalpur district. Based on their predominance in each region, a total of 9 different weed species viz., Typha latifolia, Rumex crispus, Ageratum conyzoides, Chenopodium album, Eichhornia crassipes, Ammannia auriculata, Sida acuta and Cyperus rotundus were sampled. Plant growth promoting rhizobacteria were isolated using serial dilution technique on King's B medium and were screened for tolerance to various heavy metals. The formation of bright zone with yellowish fluorescent colour by the culture in the dark colour medium indicated siderophore production. The isolates with positive plate assay were further analyzed by Arnow assay for the detection of catechol-type siderophore. Among 58 rhizosphere isolates, 10 were able to produce siderophore. The maximum siderophore production was recorded in Enterobacter sp. (TLB1) (66.30 ± 3.21 µg mg⁻¹ protein) followed by *B. subtilis* $(RCB3) (54.6 \pm 2.14 \mu g mg^{-1} protein).$

Cadmium Uptake by *Arundo donax*: Implications for Enhanced Phytoremediation

In a pot experiment, potential of *Arundo donax* was tested for cadmium (Cd) tolerance and for efficiency of Cd removal. Different cadmium concentration ranging from 0 to 1200 mg/L with EDTA supplementation @ 0, 3 and 6 ppm were applied to the pots. No adverse effect of cadmium levels was found on height and chlorophyll reflectance by leaves of *Arundo donax*. Among plant parts, maximum cadmium accumulation was observed in root followed by stem and leaves. Supplementation of EDTA @ 3 and 6 ppm enhanced cadmium accumulation in root as compared to control suggesting that EDTA can substantially enhance the efficiency of Cd removal.
